- 3-The writings on the white walls






• The clock will be centralized.

 The information panel of the clock will be written on the white floor in black In front of the clock.



- There will be two WHITE buff seats on the sides of the clock.
- An "LCD" display screen will be hanging 2– 2.5 meter from the flooring and is set at the end wall of the room.
- Direct Lights on the clock, turn on when it strikes the hour.

The fencing around the clock will be glass at 50 cm height and 50 cm far from the clock.
